As you may have seen on the news, the results from the SAT tests that the children took in May 2017 have now been released. The children took tests in reading, spelling, punctuation and grammar (SPaG) and maths. We are very proud of how hard our pupils worked towards these tests and how mature they were when sitting them.

Unlike in previous years, there is no level reported and we have been given the raw score and a scaled score for each test. In short, a scaled score of 100 represents the expected standard.
