Subject: Science

<u>Link to learning</u>: This half term, year 5 will be studying forces. Pupils will understand that gravity is responsible for unsupported objects falling towards Earth and identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction.

- Use subheadings to organize your work.
- Be sure to include scientific vocabulary.
