Subject: History

Link to learning: The Bayeux Tapestry tells the story of the events surrounding the conquest of England in 1066 by the Duke of Normandy. It provides information about civil and military architecture such as castle mounds, armour consisting of a nasal helmet, hauberk and oblong shield and seafaring in the Viking tradition. The tapestry commemorates William's victory over Harold II at the Battle of Hastings.

Task: Create your own, mini version of the Bayeux Tapestry detailing the Battle of Hastings. However, try imagining that Harold II won and William was defeated. Look at the original and think how you could add an English slant to it.
