WHAT DOES THIS SCHOOL EXPECT?

Titles must be centred and underlined.

Fully written or short dates should be written in the margin and underlined.

Writing must start next to the margin unless it is a new paragraph.

All drawings, diagrams and maps should be drawn in pencil and labelled in pen.

Pencils should be used to colour in any diagrams within exercise books, not felt and gel pens.

Graphs should be drawn in pencil and labelled in pen on the horizontal and vertical axis.

Numbers of questions must be written in the margin, if there is one.

When starting a new paragraph pupils should start on the next line and indent when writing by hand or miss a line out with no indentation when typing.

Mistakes should be crossed out with one straight ruled line.

Within maths, pupils should write one digit per square.
