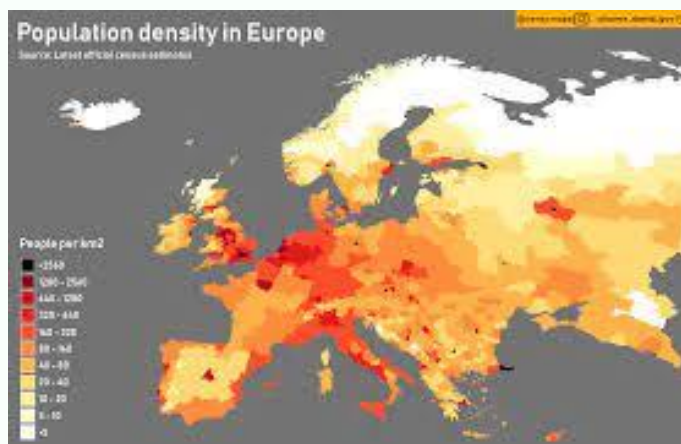
Subject: Geography

Link to learning: The UK population currently stands at approximately 67 million people. Urban areas such as cities have higher population densities than rural areas. To illustrate population density, colourised maps are used to show which areas are densely populated in black, while less densely populated areas are coloured in white.

Your task: To produce a population map of the UK, labelling major cities and their populations. Depending on density, most densely populated areas should be coloured in black e.g. London, Birmingham, Glasgow etc. As density decreases, colours such as red, orange, yellow should be used (see diagram) Sparsely populated areas should be left white.

Expectations:

- Use a blank map of the UK onto an A3 piece of paper
- Research into major cities' populations.
- Neat labelling of cities and their populations.
- Colouring in neat and not rushed.
